
RORY NELLIS



A cellist and an uilleann piper, he has collaborated with many leading artists, from Liam O'Flynn, Bryn Terfel, Sam Shepard, Christy Moore, Stephen Rea, Jean Butler and Barry Douglas and his ground-breaking work with the West Ocean String Quartet has been lauded globally. Glenn Patterson is the author of thirteen novels. His first feature film, Good Vibrations, was winner of the script award 2012 Dinard Festival and received a BAFTA nomination 'best newcomer' 2014. Glenn has received the Rooney Prize for Irish Literature (1988), Betty Trask Award (1988), Lannan Foundation Literary Fellowship (2008/9) and was elected to Aosdána 2007.




